*Bien: German term, that apprehends beehives as one coherent organism. Single bees are seen as parts of the internal organs of the beehive.


turtle sunning underground

The Votive Garage was built in downtown Vienna in the end of the 1950s and opened in 1960. In the architecture, of the oldest underground car park in Vienna, I find many analogies to the animal kingdom, shapes that represent personal protective housing for animals. The vaults, as they appear in the first basement, which have a round light shaft on the surface within the vault represent turtle shells for me. The descent ramp from the first to the second basement is like a spiral, like the entrance to a snail shell.

The analogies to these animals do not surprise me, since they form a closely interwoven network of recurring symbols, feelings and terms with the then current political events of the Cold War, as well as the Austrian history of the first half of the 20th century. The garage is an underground base, a place of security, a place of retreat for people, made of concrete. At the same time, it is a repository for man's artificial shell, which is made of sheet metal and glass. His shell makes him an ultra-mobile being, it is his privatized armor. The shell can not only be safely stored there, it also receives the nourishment, care and maintenance it needs to continue to function. It offers people security, independence, freedom and, if necessary, the opportunity to flee. Concrete, like gold, expresses the desire for stability, resistance and safety, but it is also the material from which bunkers are made.

Due to the material nature of the plastic, the project was canceled by the garage operators for fire protection reasons.

TRANSIT INFINITE





I scanned objects of this staircase, as well as my own body with the Kinect 3D Camera. The scanned 3D objects (stairs, railings, etc.) I arranged, assembled and animated together in some videos. The presentation of this work took place in the same stairway, as a projection of my MacBook desktop.

I was concerned with the question of moving forward and stagnation in situations and stages of life.



MELT INTO THIN AIR

For my installation at the Open House Day of Kunstakademie Düsseldorf 2020, I dealt with the practice of designing ornamental decorations, flowerbeds and paths in baroque gardens. I realized three images, that were between 250 cm and 320 cm in scale. Two of the gravel shapes are taken from Hieronymus Bosch's Garden of Earthly Delights.

Subordinating nature to a larger idea and thus leading it to its ideal set the tone in many ways in the architecture, art and ideology of the Baroque. Due to their two-dimensional subdivisions, Baroque gardens look like oversized board games to me, their sculptures and cut trees like play figures that could be moved by huge hands.

On the other hand, I was concerned with Hieronymus Bosch's Garden of Earthly Delights in this context. I interpret the work as the wish that the sweet and the bitter, all the heaviness and the suffering on earth should be dissolved and transformed into pleasure.


